


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Introduction

Capital letters are used at the beginning of names of places.

Examples Tanga, Kinondoni, Tanzania, Kenya

Capital letters are used at the beginning of a sentence.

Examples Read your book.

The child is crying.

Hamis and Paulina are friends.

Capital letters are used when you write days of the week.

Examples Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

Capital letters are used after full stops.

Examples Hamis and Paulina are friends. They always go to school together.

Capital letters are also used to write the months of the year.

These are January, February, March, April, May,
June, July, August, September, October,
November and December.
